What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Splash!</u></p> <p>We will introduce our new topic, Splash!</p> <p>We will discuss how we use water.</p>  <p>We will develop our fine motor skills as we paint walls and fences with water.</p> 	<p>Talk to your child about how we use water. What do they notice? Do they have any questions about water?</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will read stories about the use of water such as The Flying Bath and The Drop Goes Plop.</p>  <p>We will think about making watery noises and saying words that sound like water e.g. splash, drip, pitter patter.</p> 	<p>Look at information books about how we use water.</p> <p>Listen out to sounds around you at home or out and about - what words can you say to describe the sound e.g. Aeroplane noise - "neeeeeooowww", Car sound - "brrrrrooom", rain - "pitter patter", stamping in a puddle "splash".</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will continue to practise counting and recognising numbers.</p> 	<p>Encourage your child to count, starting from different numbers. Support them to count back from ten or twenty.</p>
