Topic - Once Upon a Tale

Our story this week will be Little Red Riding Hood. We will break down the story into parts and make story maps to help retell the story.





Can your child retell The Gingerbread Man from last week? Can they draw a picture and add a speech bubble or thought bubble? Can they get into character and answer questions as if they were the character? Can they use some more descriptive words when telling a story? For example, In the <u>deep</u>, <u>dark</u> forest.

You child could write a list of words which end in ed, est or ing. How many could they think of? They could write a story using these words.
