We will find out about different types of boats and submarines.




We will explore floating and sinking.

Have you ever travelled on a boat, ferry or even a hovercraft? Where did you go? If you have any photos please send in.


Play with different toys and containers in the bath, sink or water tray. Do they float or sink? What happens to it if you fill up a container?
