





Next Week in Nursery

What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Splash!</u></p> <p>This week we will be talking about different bodies of water including puddles, ponds, bogs, swamps and rivers.</p> 	<p>Go out splashing in puddles (or a paddling pool if it isn't raining!) Go for a walk near a pond, stream or river. What do you notice?</p> <p>What animals do you know that live in ponds, rivers or swamps?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>We will read stories about puddles, ponds and rivers such as The Bog Baby, River Story and Mr Gumpy's outing.</p>  <p>Alliteration:- We will play Guess Who? to encourage the children to hear the same sounds at the beginning of words. 'This animal is sssslippery! It is sssslimy. It is sssscaly! What do you think it is?'</p>	<p>Read stories about ponds and rivers. What kind of creatures live in them?</p>  <p>Play alliteration games. Show your child a group of objects. Can they find the objects that start with the same sound? Can your child find any more household objects that start with the sound?</p> <p>Alliteration is where 2 or more words start with the same sound. For example, fun, fish, feast.</p> <p>For example, <u>s</u>ock, <u>s</u>nake, <u>s</u>at</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will explore capacity and learn to understand the language: full, nearly full, half-full and empty.</p> 	<p>Play with different containers in your bath, washing up bowl or paddling pool.</p> <p>Support your child to fill different sized containers with water, use vocabulary such as empty, full, half empty, half-full, almost full, almost empty. Ask questions such as Which one holds the most? Which one holds the least? How do you know that?</p>

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You could test which containers hold the most and least by using a spoon to move water into them, counting how many spoonful's go into each container.
