What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic - Splash!</u></b></p> <p>We will learn about pirates and mermaids. We will discuss how boats were used in the past.</p> 	<p>Read some stories about pirates, ship wrecks and mermaids. Your child could dress up as a pirate or mermaid. You could talk about sea adventures, hunting for treasure and treasure maps.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>We will read stories about pirates and mermaids.</p> <p>We will make treasure maps.</p> 	<p>Practise holding a pencil to write and draw. Can your child write the letters of their name from the correct starting point?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>We will count and combine groups of objects. We will practise recognising numbers.</p> 	<p>Practise counting amounts of objects such as toys, Lego blocks or biscuits.</p> <p>Try counting two groups of different objects, for example, blue Lego bricks, yellow Lego bricks.</p> <p>How many do you have altogether?</p>

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### Additional learning

This week, the children will make a picture and letter for their new teachers to tell them something about themselves.



Talk to your child about how they feel about moving into a new class or school. Write down any questions they have. We can discuss these in class and their new teachers can visit us too.

Talk to your child about what they like doing at school, for example, drawing, role-play, playing musical instruments, painting or building.
