

#### Colour-themed week

Next week we will be having a week all about colours.

Practise identifying and naming colours with any objects or toys, for example, Duplo bricks.

Try playing "I - Spy with my little eye, something coloured...."

Try going on a colour hunt to look for objects of different colours – you can do this inside or outside, even using natural objects that you might find on a walk e.g. green acorns, red leaves.

#### Maths

We will sort objects by colour. We will practise counting small amounts of objects.



Practise counting small amounts of objects with your child. You could count different coloured flowers or cars on your way home from school!


Try sorting objects into different coloured pots or buckets.
