<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Rhyme Time</u></p> <p>This week we will begin our <u>Rhyme Time</u> topic. We will discuss our favourite rhymes and songs, focusing on the rhymes:</p> <p>Baa, Baa Black Sheep Mary had a Little Lamb and Little Bo Peep.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;"></div>	<p>Sing nursery rhymes and action songs with your child. You could encourage them to clap or stamp their feet to the rhythm.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Baa, baa black sheep Have you any wool? "Yes, sir. Yes sir. Three bags full!" One for the Master, And one for the Dame, And one for the little boy, Who lives down the lane.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Little Bo Peep has lost her sheep, And doesn't know where to find them. Leave them alone and they'll come home, Wagging their tails behind them.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Mary had a little lamb Its fleece was white as snow; And everywhere that Mary went The lamb was sure to go.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">It followed her to school one day Which was against the rule; It made the children laugh and play To see a lamb at school.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will start to look at some familiar numerals, including 1, 2 and 3.</p>	<p>Talk to your child about the numbers they see in the world around them. These could be door numbers, numbers on birthday cards/cakes/balloons, numbers on buses, numbers on road signs etc.</p>
