
## Next Week in Nursery Week Beginning 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024



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Maths	
We will be counting, recognising and ordering numbers from 1-5, then 1-10.	Look at the numbers on your front door and others you pass out and about.
	Try labelling some building blocks with numbers (on a sticker or post-it note) and see if your child can build a tower with them, starting with 1 at the bottom and building up with the numbered bricks in the right order.
	For a counting challenge, try counting from different numbers, for example: 4-8 and stop 2-7 and stop Can your child remember where to begin and stop?
	You can make it funny by using different voices, for example, a squeaky voice, a whispery voice, a shouty voice.
<u>Other</u>	
We will learn a little about Remembrance Day on Monday 11 <sup>th</sup> November and look at the whole-school artwork to spot Rainbow class's poppies.
