

## English

We will be exploring all of our senses by reading books that focus on each sense.

We will be focusing on getting our sentences correctly demarcated with capital letters and full stops whilst writing a variety of genres: stories, information texts, recipes and letters!

## Maths

We'll be working on number bonds within and of 10, addition and subtraction to 10 and looking at all 8 fact families number sentences. We finish the term looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

## Art

We will be focussing on the artist Kandinsky. The children will get to create some lively pieces of art by painting the sounds and colours they hear while listening to inspirational music.

## Science

Not only will we be finding and identifying as many different parts of the human body as we can, we will be exploring each of the 5 main senses in detail! Each week we'll take a main sense and through fun and exciting experiments, we'll discover how we use it to interact with the world around us.

We'll also continue to investigate what happens in autumn. This will include a walk to Ladywell Fields to observe what autumn looks like in our local area.
