Spellings

Friday 29th November is Xmas Dress Up Day and Tombola Drop Off. Come in Xmasy/Festive clothing.

Starting from next week, the children will be having a spelling guiz on Fridays. We will let you know the words that will be in the guiz each week so that they can be practised at home. The words in each quiz are selected as they are either frequently used and incorrectly spelt words, common exception words and/or words that we will most likely use in our writing next week.

This week's spelling quiz words:

Around, most, looked, path, hold

When practising at home, start off by letting your child see the word and copy it up. Then see your child can cover the word up and spell it correctly from memory. Keep practising till they are confident and accurate. Make practising these words memorable by writing with and on different materials, or against the clock. Get the stopwatch up on your phone, how many times can they write one of the words in a minute? Can they write the chosen word more times in a minute than you can?

If the guiz highlights there is still a word or two your child is finding problematic, we will support them with learning and memorising them during what is left of the week.

Take a look at this picture – if you were there, what would you be able to see, hear,



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
This week the children are learning the story 'Toby and the Great Fire of London'. 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History: The Great Fire of London

Next week the children will be answering the question: Why did the fire spread so quickly? They will be looking at a number of factors that contributed and decide which they feel was the largest contributor.



Science:

As we continue our weather unit, we will be turning our focus to temperature. During the lesson, we will be looking at UK temperature and making comparisons with the temperatures in other countries.
