### This week's spelling quiz words:

More, know, what, have, improve

When practising at home, start off by letting your child see the word and copy it up. Then see your child can cover the word up and spell it correctly from memory. Keep practising till they are confident and accurate. Make practising these words memorable by writing with and on different materials, or against the clock. Get the stopwatch up on your phone, how many times can they write one of the words in a minute? Can they write the chosen word more times in a minute than you can?

If the quiz highlights there is still a word or two your child is finding problematic, we will support them with learning and memorising them during what is left of the week.

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
#### Maths

Computing: The children will be putting everything they have learnt about photography into practise. They will take photos, thinking about framing, focus, lighting and effects.
