<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic -On the Move</u></p> <p>Our new Topic will be On the Move. We will focus on different modes of transport.</p> <p>We will think about how we move around our local environment.</p>  <p>Zara will help the children to make 'scooter bling' for their scooter or bike.</p>	<p>During the school holidays, talk about ways we get around, locally and when travelling further away.</p> <p>Perhaps you could explore how a mode of transport has changed throughout history.</p>

Using objects such as fruit, can they find different ways to make the number?</p> <p>Talk about the different ways you travel. You could count the cars that pass along your road during five minutes. Look at the colour and the type of vehicles.</p>
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<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p><u>New digraphs:</u> ai ee igh oa</p> <p><u>Graphemes learnt so far:</u> s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, ll, ff, j, ss, v, w, x, y, z, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk</p> <p><u>Tricky words taught so far:</u> is, I, the, pull, full, put, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, he, push, of, we, me, be</p>	<p>Try a Hide and Seek game with words. You could give clues for your child to work out where each word is hidden! Don't forget to have a go yourself!</p>
