What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic - Help!</u></p> <p>We will learn about how medical staff help us, including doctors, nurses and paramedics.</p>  <p>We will discuss our experiences at a doctors' surgery or hospital.</p>	<p>Watch programmes such <i>Get Well Soon</i> on CBeebies and read information books about medical staff.</p> <p>Discuss visits to the doctor, nurse or hospital that your child has experienced. What was the reason for the visit? How did the doctor or nurse help?</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>We will read information books about different medical occupations such as doctors, nurses and paramedics.</p> <p>The children will be role playing in a doctors' surgery and outside as paramedics, speeding to emergencies on their scooters and bicycles.</p> <p>They will be making and writing get well soon cards.</p>   <p>We will begin to explore rhyming words. Rhyming words are words that end in the same sounds. e.g. <u>cat</u> and <u>hat</u></p>	<p>Read stories or information books about people who help.</p> <p>Look out for ambulances and discuss why they are in a hurry if they have a siren or flashing lights on.</p>  <p>Think of a pair of words and ask your child to repeat them. Then ask do those words rhyme? e.g. dog, log, you say them. Do they rhyme? Yes they do because they sound the same at the end.</p>

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Cup, train, you say them. Do they rhyme? No they don't because they sound different at the end.

Here are some examples of rhyming pairs.



Maths

We will practise matching numerals and quantities.

We will be practising counting out amounts using pretend medicine pills and numbers of spoons of medicine.

We will be highlighting the importance of only taking medicine when given by an adult.



Play games such as Snap and "I Spy" with numerals and different quantities.

Encourage your child to notice numbers around them and count small amounts of objects accurately (saying each number name as they count each object)

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Other

We will be pouring, ladling and mixing coloured medicine (water) into bottles and other containers in the water tray.
