What we will be doing in school	How you can help at home
Topic - Help!	
We will learn about some ways that police officers help us.	Discuss how police officers help us in different ways.
We will take our fingerprints and make art work using our fingers.	Take a tray of objects, show them to your child, cover the tray and remove one object without your child seeing. Show them the tray again and see if they can work out the missing object. Start with a few objects then add more to tray to increase the difficulty!
We will have a visit from a Police Officer on Monday 27 th January to tell us more about what they do to help people.	
<u>Literacy</u>	
We will read stories and information books about Police and Police vehicles.	Read stories or information books about people who help us.
<u>Maths</u>	Watch either of the Lunar New Year stories
We will be linking some of our Maths to the Lunar New Year story of the Great Race. We will introduce the language of first, second, third, fourth, fifth etc (called ordinal numbers) for the positions the animals finished in the race.	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eVClAj8q_IY https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=x81zCOzE58E Talk about the story, see if the children can name the animals from the race. Discuss using the words first, second, third etc who won the race and the order the animals finished in.

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We will look at small amounts of treasure and coins and work out how many there are.

Look at arrangements of objects (up to 5 to start) - can you child describe what they see and how they see it? (e.g. "I can they see 2 things and another 2 things")
