<u>Maths</u>

This week in maths we will dive deeper into our knowledge of number! We will continue to focus on 6, 7 and 8, exploring different ways to make them.

We will continue our work on part-whole models, seeing how two parts add together to make the whole.





Have a go making 6, 7 and 8 in different ways! Find different combinations on dice, use physical items to move or draw tens frames on paper!

Record your findings as number sentences and in part-whole models as seen below!

Phonics

<u>Focus of the week:</u> Reviewing the sounds and tricky words taught this term!

Review the taught sounds and ensure children are able to recognise them as they are written, find them within words and can write them if dictated aloud.

When reading books, can you spot any two syllable words? Practise 'chunking' them up, e.g. sunset = sun / set. Read half the word at a time then put them back together to read the full word.

Keep reviewing the taught sounds, ensuring children can read them and spot them within words! Become digraph detectives, hunting for digraphs in the words before trying to read them!
